

Fill the area frenzy! (2+ players)

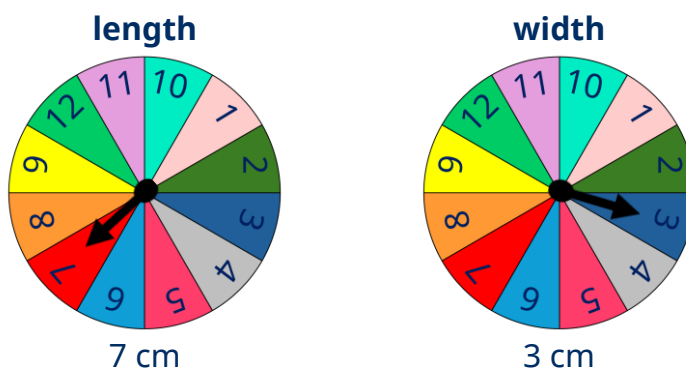


Equipment needed

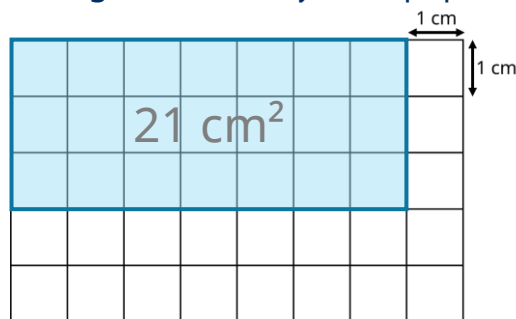
- Spinner
- Split pin
- Squared centimetre paper
- Coloured pencils (optional)

Instructions

1. All players take a piece of squared paper to create their rectangles.
2. Player 1 spins the spinner twice.
The first number the arrow lands on represents the **length** of their rectangle (in centimetres) and the second number the arrow lands on represents the **width** of their rectangle (in centimetres).



3. Player 1 draws their rectangle on their squared paper (in centimetres).



4. Player 1 writes the area of their rectangle, in cm², by multiplying the length and width together, or by counting squares.
5. Player 2 repeats.
Players continue to use the spinner to draw and calculate the area of different rectangles on their squared paper.

The winner is the **first** player to completely fill their squared paper with rectangles with no (or the least number of) blank squares remaining.
