Why do you think Jem doesn't want to get older?

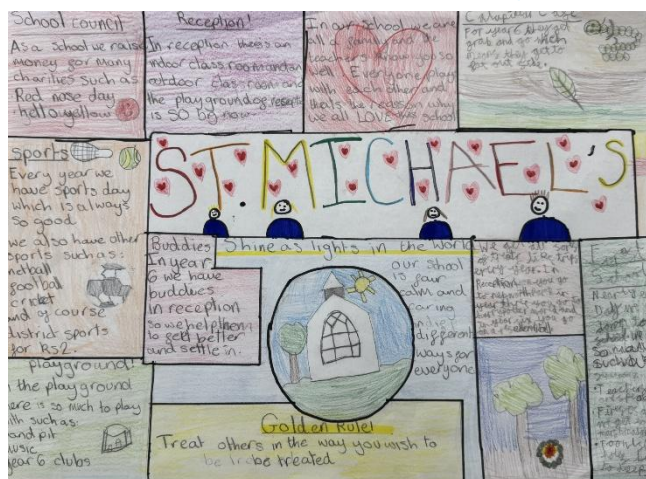
