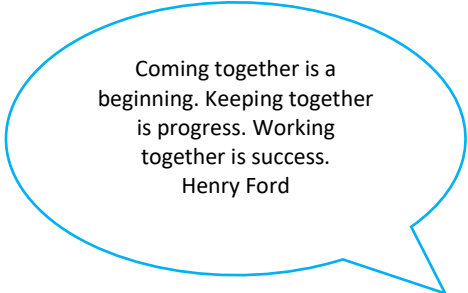


Our School Value for the month of June is 'Cooperation'

KS1 and KS2 girls were treated to a dance class on Tuesday run by 'This Girl Can.' It was lots of fun, and they all learnt some great moves!

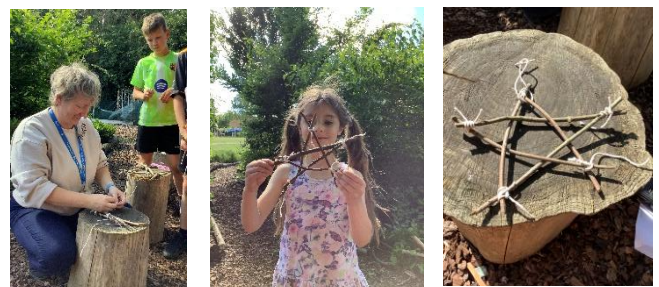
