

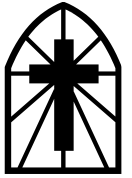

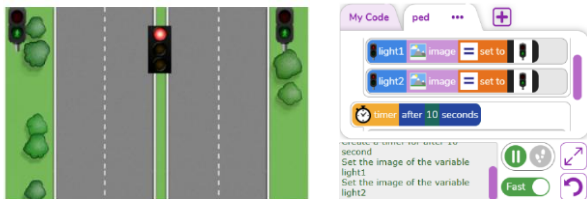


### Our Crossing Engagement Day

He showed some pictures of plans the children had made last year, where they had identified having a lower speed limit, a wider footpath, crossings and yellow line to stop cars parking on the busy junction, which were very intuitive.

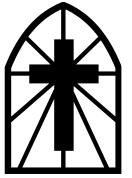
