

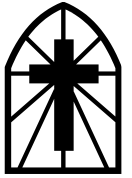

### KS2 Harvest Pilgrimage

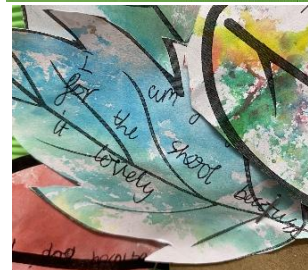
